1.0 Statement of Company Safety Policy

- Maintain our premises and sites that are under our control to a high standard;
- Give priority to health and safety in all our operations;
- Consult and involve our staff in all matters affecting health and safety;
- Engage external resources and specialist support to assist with safety management, safety process and safety procedures;

We require the full and active participation of all management, employees and contractors in order that the principles outlined in this policy statement may be achieved. The statutory duties placed on the O'Reilly Group, inclusive of our management, employees, contractors and suppliers, is seen as the minimum standard to which we must adhere too.
